JOB PURPOSE:

The children/youth Director directs and co-ordinates activities associated with discipleship and outreach ministries to children and youth in the Corps and the community.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- To promote and supervise all existing programs for children, youth and young adults within the Corps.
- Contributes to the spiritual development of the children and youth by mentoring, discipling, encouraging, and modeling appropriate Christian attitudes and behaviours.
- To seek to develop new ministries where possible, so as to increase the level of spiritual maturity among our youth and to provide outreach to the unsaved.
- To provide a pastoral support to all children /youth and young adults that may be involved in various ministries.
- Outreach to parents/guardians of the children/youth involved in YP ministries
- To plan, promote and supervise '*special events*' (Rally Day, VBS. Camps and other Divisional Youth opportunities) that would serve as a means of reaching the youth of our community
- Co-ordinates, implements, maintains and assists in the evaluation of programs/ministries relevant to the youth of the church and the community at large.
- Plans and conducts creative worship services, evangelistic outreach, care programs and Bible studies as applicable.
- May develop and implement appropriate leadership development programs for youth and those involved in youth leadership; recruits, orients and trains volunteer leaders
- Conducts regular leadership team meetings
- Maintains written records, logs of activities, statistics, etc.
- Performs General Office duties and other duties as assigned
- Has input to and/or participates in preparing budgets with respect to the Youth Department
- Be willing to make Park Street Citadel your home Corps and attendance at Sunday meetings is an essential part of the mentoring and discipling the children / youth

Specifically, the Youth Director will give oversight for:

Pioneer Club, Junior Soldiers, Cradle Roll, Nursery Program, VBS,
Rally Day, Cross Zones and Cross Training, Youth Group

QUALIFICATIONS

The successful candidate should:

- Have a strong personal Christian commitment and spiritual maturity
- Have a passion for youth and youth ministry
- Be a Salvation Army soldier (preferred but not necessary) who adheres to and supports the mission, policies and principles of The Salvation Army.
- Have demonstrated successful involvement in working with Church youth (not less than one year of prior related experience working with children and youth)
- Have completed high school
- Have Youth Leadership Training and Biblical studies
- Be willing to work with other church ministries and community organizations in relation to children/youth activities
- Must be a Team Player
- Have Computer Skills and be proficient in Microsoft Office products including PowerPoint, Publisher and Word
- Obtain a police check and clearance through The Salvation Army internal abuse registry
